Delegation	 6 Men and 6 Women athletes and 2 Officials (exception 8 Men or 8 Women athletes when participating Standard Rifle). These athletes must have an official ISSF ID- number. Per event 5 athletes and 1 team can be employed. If a nation has registered more than 5 shooters at a European Cup, so all registered participants can start per discipline as guests. Guests can take part in the competition or discipline if the number of targets is available without an additional relay. The guests figure on the normal ranking list and can also win medals. However, guests cannot win European Cup points
