## Protection Concept 300m LAPUA European Cup Final from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021 in Winterthur

final version/18.08.2021

### Basic information

Due to the 5<sup>th</sup> relaxation measures of the Federal Council/FOPH of 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021, the 30th 300m LAPUA European Cup Final can be held under the following conditions.

In order to keep the spread of the Covid19 pandemic under control, the following basic rules must also be observed in shooting sports:

- Only symptom-free persons appear at the competition  
(If a person from the delegation has symptoms, the competition management must be informed by the head of the delegation).
- Strict adherence to hygiene rules
- Keep 1.5m distance whenever possible

### Arrival

- Every person at this event (athletes, coaches, delegation members, officials and staff as well as guests and spectators) must be able to present an appropriate certificate according to the **3-G-rule (vaccinated/tested/healed)** or a negative rapid test or PCR-test with a smartphone (photo), which has been taken no longer than 48 hours ago. An entry control will be carried out.
- No tests will be offered on site.
- On the following days (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) persons who have registered on the first day (Thursday) do not have to show any certificates.

### Shooting range 300m outdoor

- At the 300m shooting range, all persons are not required to wear masks in accordance with the Swiss Shooting Sport Federation protection concept for outdoor ranges (26.06.2021).

### Indoors

- In indoor areas (anteroom to the shooting range, offices, toilet facilities, changing rooms, etc.) all persons must wear masks when entering.

### Information/disinfectants

- Official FOPH posters with rules of conduct at various locations refer to the "Covid19 Pandemic" rules of conduct.
- Stations with hand disinfectants are available at the stand entrance.

### **At the shooting range**

- There will be no disinfection of the stands and utensils (control boxes, monitors, firing point area, etc.) between rounds.

### **Shooting preparation of the athletes / stay in the shooting range**

- The dressing and preparation of the athletes for shooting shall take place outside the shooting range (dressing rooms in the basement) or in the zone in front of the firing point.
- Rotation (running around) in the shooting range is not desired and must be kept to a minimum.

### **Stay of the athletes outside of the shooting range**

- This will take place outside the shooting range or in the designated areas (foyer of the shooting range or restaurant).
- Large gatherings and crowding are to be avoided.

### **Restaurant**

- In the restaurant, masks must be worn from the entrance to the seating area. No mask need be worn when seated. However, as soon as the person gets up, the mask must be put back on (e.g. for visiting the toilets, taking a smoke break, leaving the restaurant, etc.).
- In the outdoor area of the restaurant (forecourt) there are no restrictions and there is no obligation to wear a mask.
- There are no restrictions on the number of persons at a table.
- Furthermore, the regulations of Gastro Swiss apply.

### **Personal responsibility**

- This is explicitly pointed out

This protection concept is valid as a basic document for this event on the basis of the submission/regulations of the Swiss Shooting Sport Federation of 26.06.2021.  
Short-term adjustments (e.g. restrictions by the canton) remain reserved.
