## 1. SCHEDULE

## 4. JURIES AND RANGE OFFICERS

The Technical Delegates, Juries, Referees and other officials will be designated to conduct the competitions.

## 5. PARTICIPATION

Three (3) highest ranked national teams, **in each event**, according to the European Ranking at the end of the qualifying period of the year (Paris 2024 Olympic Games), plus the national team of the nation hosting the League (total four (4) national teams) will be invited to take part.

In case the team of the hosting nation is among the top three (3) ranked, then the 4th ranked team will be invited.

In case one (or more) of the four (4) top ranked national teams does not confirm participation, then the next ranked national team (teams) will be invited.

The place in the European ranking, **in each event**, will be determined by the addition of the ranking points of the top two (2) highest ranked Men and the top two (2) highest ranked Women of each nation.

Each national team will be composed of 2 Men & 2 Women in each event. Each athlete must have points in the European ranking.

*In case the host Federation does not have 2 Men and 2 Women in the Ranking, it can invite 1 Man and 1 Woman from neighboring countries to form a Team. Invited athletes cannot be from countries which qualified to the Champions League, they must be in the European Ranking and can compete in the individual duels only.*

## **6. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

- a) Each participating Member Federation, in each event, will receive a grant in the amount of 10.000 (ten thousand) Euro to prepare and send its Team(s) to the Tournament.
- b) Prize money in each event (paid to the Member Federations):
- 1<sup>st</sup> place – 10.000 (ten thousand) Euro
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 7.500 (seven thousand five hundred) Euro
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 5.000 (five thousand) Euro
  - 4<sup>th</sup> place – 2.500 (two thousand five hundred) Euro

## **7. ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUAL ESC CHALLENGE EVENT**

*One individual ESC Challenge event – Solo – will be included in the program for the athletes competing in the ESC Champions League.*

*Each participating Team in each event will select 1 Men and 1 Women to take part in the competition.*

*Prize money for each participating athlete will be established. The winner of each Solo completion will receive a special Trophy.*

## **8. ENTRY PROCESS**

The Qualified Teams will be notified by the ESC secretariat and will be asked to complete the attached Final Entry Form (Annex 1), which must be returned to the ESC Secretariat by the established deadlines.

## **9. OFFICIAL HOTEL/ACCOMMODATION**

Each Team in each event will be allocated in the official hotel, three (3) rooms free of charge for accommodating its athletes and official(s) for three (3) nights (full-board).

Additional accommodation or extra charges (telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals, laundry etc.) that may occur, must be paid directly to the hotel.
